



Forum on Advancing Digital Transformation through Public Sector Innovation in the South-East Asia Region

17 July 2025 (Bangkok, Thailand)

There is an increasing demand for the digitalization of public administration, driven by rapid advancements in technologies such as Artificial Intelligence (AI), big data, and cloud technologies. Digital government is recognized as a key enabler of administrative efficiency and enhanced public service delivery, underscoring the need for continuous innovation in the public sector. Despite this momentum, significant disparities remain in the development of digital governments across ASEAN countries. Fragmented administrative systems and limited cross-border integration continue to hinder regional cooperation. These challenges highlight the urgent need to strengthen connectivity through interoperable digital government systems, effective data sharing, and deeper institutional collaboration.

In this context, the Embassy of the Republic of Korea to Thailand and the Asian and Pacific Training Centre for ICT for Development (APCICT/ESCAP) are co-organizing a forum on the theme: "Advancing Digital Transformation through Public Sector Innovation" to be held on 17 July 2025 in Bangkok, Thailand.

This forum seeks to leverage Korea's experience in digital governance and promote partnerships that support ASEAN's digital transformation journey. Through the collaboration with APCICT/ESCAP, the forum will examine the current landscape and future direction of digital transformation in the Republic of Korea and member states in the South-East Asia region. It will bring together policymakers, experts, and practitioners for knowledge sharing, discussions, and presentations focusing especially on the role of public sector innovation and the transformative potential of AI in public service delivery.

OBJECTIVES

- Strengthen collaboration between the Republic of Korea and ASEAN countries in building more inclusive, efficient, and interoperable digital government systems.
- Promote knowledge sharing and regional collaboration on digital government innovations among member states in the South-East Asia region.
- Explore the role of emerging technologies such as AI in enhancing public sector efficiency and service delivery.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES

- Enhanced mutual understanding of digital government strategies, innovations, and best practices across the Republic of Korea and ASEAN countries in Asia and the Pacific region.
- Identified opportunities for collaboration on interoperable digital government systems, data sharing, and the responsible use of emerging technologies such as AI.
- Strengthened partnership and policy insights to support future joint initiatives aimed at accelerating inclusive digital transformation in the region.
