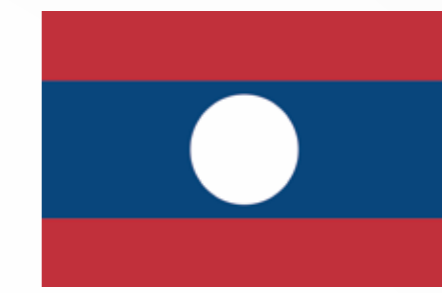

The Ministry of Home Affairs (MOHA), formerly known as Public Administration and Civil Service Authority (PACSA), was officially established on June 30th of 2011. The Ministry of Home Affairs is a government organization that acts as the Secretariat to the government at the macro level.



WHAT WE DO

MOHA is responsible for assisting the Government of Lao PDR regarding public administration at the central and local level. It is also in charge of civil service management; civil society regulations and management; geographical, ethnic and religious matters; and citizen management and competitions - awards in the country.

MOHA has collaborated with the National Governance and Public Administration Reform, which is funded by the UNDP in order to strengthen good governance, public administration reform and socio-economic development.
